A botanist for the U.S. Geological Survey in Tucson, Arizona, Janice Emily Bowers has written several books about southwestern flora. They include *100 Desert Wildflowers of the Southwest*, *100 Roadside Wildflowers of Southwest Woodlands*, *Shrubs and Trees of the Southwest Deserts*, *Sonoran Desert Plants: An Ecological Atlas*, and *Desert: The Mojave and Death Valley*. She has also published several collections of essays about the desert, including *A Full Life in a Small Place and Other Essays from a Desert Garden* and *Fear Falls Away and Other Essays from Hard and Rocky Places*,

Bowers has received numerous grants and awards, including two USGS Special Achievement Awards and a grant from the University of Arizona Foundation. She is an elected fellow of the Arizona-Nevada Academy of Science.
