Lyndon B. Johnson National Historical Park continues its popular summer movie series with the movie *Yogi Bear* to be shown on the LBJ Ranch near Stonewall on Saturday, July 9.

*Yogi Bear* is a 2010 American live-action film adaptation of the Hanna-Barbera cartoon series. The film stars Dan Aykroyd, Justin Timberlake, Tom Cavanagh, Anna Faris, T.J. Miller, Nate Corddry, and Andrew Daly. The film tells the story of Yogi Bear as he tries to save his park from being logged and shut down.

Free of charge, the movie will be presented on a giant outdoor screen with professional sound beginning around sunset. The public can drive onto the LBJ Ranch beginning at 7:00 pm. Bring lawn chairs or quilts for seating comfort and your choice of refreshments. This is the best way to experience what friends and neighbors of the Johnsons did back in the 1960s when they watched movies in the ranch airplane hangar for their evening entertainment.
